The Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), is a pro-disclosure law intended for all citizens to have the right to access public documents of their government.

[B] Under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") Act, all requests must be in writing and directed to the General Counsel of the District as follows:

The statutory period for complying with or denying a FOIA request shall not begin until the request is received by the Office of the General Counsel. Pursuant to Section 6 of the FOIA, for black and white copies, the first 50 pages are free, and any additional pages will cost 15 cents a page. For color copies or abnormal size copies, the charge will be the actual charge incurred for contracting with a vendor to perform the photo-coping services.
