REPORTS

that in Board Report No. 27358 adopted 5-4-06, the Board approved the purchase of three 4-Door, 4-Wheel Drive 2007 Ford Hybrid Escapes for the Security Department at Kenney-King College; and

that there is a need to amend the report to correct the funding information to reflect that the funding will be changed from the Educational Purposes Fund to the Capital Outlay Fund; and

that it is proposed that the 2007 Ford Hybrid Escapes, with standard equipment, oxford white clear coat exterior, premium cloth interior, and well equipped with standard features be purchased through the City of Chicago contract with Sutton Ford, Matteson, IL., Contract No. 7182, with a contract term through 12/31/2007. Sutton Ford has proposed to provide the security vehicles for \$27,675 each, which includes any logos or lettering required for \$83,025 for three SUVs; and

that this purchase under the City of Chicago contract is exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced vehicle purchase opportunity and has determined that since Sutton Ford is a certified MBE and has requested a waiver from WBE compliance and the vehicles are being purchased through the City of Chicago contract (#7182), it is recommended that the request for a waiver from WBE compliance be granted.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS that the Board of Trustees authorize the amendment of the funding information for the purchase of three 4x4 Ford Escape from Sutton Ford, Matteson, IL for \$83,025 as detailed below.
