**Other Business:**

Executive Vice Chancellor, Deidra Lewis reported on the end of term enrollment for Summer 2007.

At the end of the summer, unduplicated headcount enrollment reached 36,540 students, a decrease of 5.5% compared to summer 2006. FTE enrollment reached 16,793, a decrease of 3.1%.

Credit headcount enrollment reached 12,670 students, an increase of 0.7% over last summer. Credit FTE enrollment 8,357, a 3.4% increase.

Adult Education headcount enrollment reached 16,768, a decrease of 9.5% compared to summer 2006. Adult FTE enrollment reached 7,521, a decrease of 6.9%.

An end-of-term enrollment for the fall will be presented will be presented in January.

END-OF-TERM ENROLLMENT REPORT: SUMMER 2007

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS that beginning with the Summer 2007 semester, enrollments reports will shift from reporting by processing types to careers as classified in PeopleSoft. Comparisons to the Summer 2006 semester are also measured in careers for the purpose of this report.

As of the end of Summer 2007, unduplicated headcount enrollment in all programs reached 36,540 students (Table 1). This represents a decrease of 5.5% compared to Summer 2006. The Full-Time-Equivalent (FTE) enrollment reached 16,793 FTE students (Table 2), a decrease of 3.1%

Headcount enrollment in the career credit program—which includes credit, pre-credit, and manufacturing/technology—reached 12,670 students, an increase of 0.7 percent over the previous year. The credit FTE enrollment reached 8,357 FTE students, which represents a 3.4% increase over the previous year.

Headcount enrollment in vocational skills reached 1,031 students, a decrease of 19.6% compared to Summer 2006 (Table 1). FTE enrollment reached 482 students, a decrease of 28.7 percent (Table 2).

Headcount enrollment in continuing education (which includes special interest in headcount only) reached 6,868 students, a decrease of 9.5% compared to Summer 2006 (Table 1). FTE enrollment reached 432 students, a decrease of 12.6 percent (Table 2).

Headcount enrollment in the Adult Education program reached 16,768 students, a decrease of 9.5 percent compared to Summer 2006 (Table 1). FTE enrollment reached 7,521 FTE students, a decrease of 6.9 percent (Table 2).
