Dear Sole Source Justification Committee,

In communicating with AB&C today, I was informed of the services they currently offer, including:

- Administer processing for associated solar professional certifications for a customer's Solar PV instructor at a set price
- 2. Provide "train the trainer" services with an Instructor Certification Partnership, in which AB&C would contract with a master trainer to train an employee on a customer's team, who would need to be a journeyman electrician with 5 years' experience.
 - 1. Note 1- The preferred trainer of AB&C is not available for this work in the Spring 2021 timeframe.
 - 2. Note 2- Wright College/Humboldt Park does not have a potential Solar PV Installer trainer currently under contract who would meet the minimum requirements to be trained, i.e.- a journeyman electrician with 5 years' experience.

AB&C indicated they can investigate, but have not previously done in-house, the following scope requirements for the Spring 2021 and Fall 2021 cohorts funded by the Workforce Equity Grant:

- 1. Providing a customer with a Solar PV installation trainer to teach an 8 week cohort with remote and in-person instruction for laboratories
- 2. Solar PV Installer Program Recruitment
- 3. Solar PV Installer Career Placement Assistance

In terms of our Solar PV Installer needs to fulfill the WEI grant training scope of Solar PV Installer training, we need:

- A credentialed Solar PV installation training team to teach two 30 student 8 week cohorts, one starting in March, and another starting in August, both remote and inperson for labs
- 2. Administration and processing for associated solar professional certifications
- 3. A leveraged relationship that includes Solar PV Installer Program Recruitment
- 4. A leveraged relationship that includes Solar PV Installer Career Placement Assistance

At this time, only one vendor, Millennium Solar Training Academy, can fulfill our full wraparound scope needs in-house and with value added services available due to leveraged relationships with external partners during the period of the Workforce Equity Initiative grant fund availability ending October 31, 2021.
