Sole Source/Bid Waiver Justification

Below are the following Sole Source /Bid Waiver Criteria. If your purchase does meet any of the following criteria, please contact Jacinta Epting for further instruction via email at jepting4@ccc.edu.

What is a Sole Source Procurement?

A "sole source" procurement can be defined as any contract entered into without a competitive process, based on a justification that only one known source exists or that only one single supplier can fulfill the requirement. Although states generally do not permit non-competitive procurements by statute, exceptions are allowed where competition is not feasible.

Examples of acceptable exceptions from the competitive procurement process may include:

- Only one known source exists for supplies of services or products as determined by documented research.
- □ No other reasonable alternative source exists that meets the CCC requirements.
- Only one source meets the business needs of the CCC (e.g., compatibility, unique feature to meet CCC's business need, etc.)
- □ Procurement of public utility services.

What's not a Sole Source Procurement?

- □ A CCC requirement for a particular proprietary product or service does not automatically justify a sole source procurement if there is more than one potential bidder of offeror for that item.
- □ A CCC preference for a brand name product does not justify a sole source procurement.
- □ A good's or service's "uniqueness" alone may not qualify the producer or supplier of the good or service as a sole provider of a good or service.

What are acceptable considerations for sole source procurements?

CCC reasons for sole sources vary greatly but should fall within the following:

- **O** Only one known source that can provide the commodity or service.
- □ Unique source (commodity/service is unique/special in nature)
- Compatibility (e.g., a public safety CCC requiring a specific piece of equipment to be compatible with an existing equipment system)
- Limited or proprietary systems (i.e. additional licenses, updates, specialized replacement parts, etc.)
- □ A professional expert is requested.
- □ Sales territories or product availability within limited geographic boundaries.

Business Rationale

Bibliotheca is the authorized service provider for 3M Library System</u> <u>Equipment, Checkpoint models, Signature, Strata EX Plus, PX and QX detection Systems security gate systems (from</u> <u>BR33739--Vendor Selection Criteria) The City Colleges of Chicago libraries have had maintenance agreements with the</u> <u>3M company, merged with Bibliotheca in 2015, since 2011.</u>
- 2. What are the unique features of the supplies or services that are not available in any other product or by any other vendor? Provide specific, quantifiable factors/qualifications: <u>Certain parts have patents and patents pending that are held exclusively by Bibliotheca.</u>
- 3. If professional services, what are the unique qualifications this vendor possesses? Provide specific, measurable factors/qualifications: <u>The company provides the only factory-authorized service by specially-trained technicians</u>. Service agreements are exclusive to Bibliotheca and are not available elsewhere.

b. If no, why were alternatives not evaluated? <u>See #1. Bibliotheca is the sole provider of maintenance of hardware</u> security system for CCC's libraries.

- 5. What efforts were made to get the best possible price? From time to time, we must evaluate our existing infrastructure, and the cost to maintain versus new implementation. As is the case with Bibliotheca, the physical infrastructure meets the needs of each of the libraries. The cost to maintain the existing infrastructure is approximately \$30k/year, whereas a new gate cost (not including RFP resources, and training) would be more than \$25k as was evidenced by the \$37k spent at DTI to install/implement new gates to an existing library space (which also included a 1 year free maintenance/software). At the macro level, maintaining the infrastructure, and making repairs to keep the gates in working order does provide us with the best possible pricing, when compared to the cost of new implementation and installation.
- - If yes, please provide details regarding future obligations and/or needs: <u>We will continue to pay the fees as</u> long as we want to receive services from the company to secure our physical library materials.
- 7. Why is the price for this purchase considered to be fair and reasonable? <u>The physical gates are set off and make a loud noise to alert staff if patrons attempt to leave one of CCC's libraries with materials (for example, a book, compact disc, or DVD) that hasn't been properly checked out and desensitized. These materials represent a substantial investment of funds and support CCC's curriculum.</u>
- 8. If this is a renewal, describe why circumstances are such that competitive selection is still not an alternative since awarding the original contract: <u>The customized installation of hardware in CCC's libraries represent a substantial investment of time and resources</u>. The sole source status represented by the vendor for exclusive maintenance of the gates means there isn't another provider offering what CCC needs to maintain upkeep.
- 9. What will be the financial or other impact to the CCC if this sole source is not approved and a competitive bid is required? <u>We could lose service/protection of physical assets purchased by the libraries for their collections to</u> <u>serve students and faculty.</u>
