REPORTS

that the Environmental Technology Program at Wright College North, and NORBIC (North Business & Industrial Council) presented a satellite forum associated with the Federal EPA program called WASTEWISE on June 17, 1998. This was accomplished by bringing a downlink signal on the C-Bank coordinates from the Galaxy 6 satellite to the Environmental Technology classroom. The Federal EPA produced this teleconference for nationwide distribution. "Waste Prevention Pays: Businesses Cut Costs by Cutting Waste" provided business decision makers with a framework for identifying cost savings through waste reduction throughout their operations; and

that among the private-sector companies and the public agencies attending the program at Wright North were R.R. Donnelly and the Chicago Transit Authority. The EPA program included case studies from Target Stores, CITGO Petroleum Corporation and Storyfield Farm, Inc.; and

that this was the second EPA satellite downlink sponsored by Wright College. The next one will be for screen-printers in December.
