THE CHANCELLOR

that proposals, contracts, and other special funding instruments are under development or have been submitted by staff at this time.

NEW GRANTS

Physician Assistant Training (PD# 9801). Malcolm X College has requested \$165,954 from the Department of Health and Human Services to recruit (and retain) underrepresented and disadvantaged students into innovative interdisciplinary primary care focused curricula for pre-clinical and physician assistant programs. Period of performance: July 1, 1998 through June 30, 1999.

Telecommunications/Networking Solutions (PD# 9802). Wright College has requested \$9,896 from the Illinois State Library to replace old telecommunications/network equipment.

Workstation and Printer Program (PD# 9803). Wright College has requested \$13,796 from the Illinois State Library to upgrade computer equipment.

Illinois Cooperative Work Study Program (PD# 9804). Wright College has requested \$37,140 from the Illinois Board of Higher Education to partially subsidize internships for 16 students from disadvantaged communities enrolled in Basic Manufacturing, Computer Numerical Control, Machining, and Electrical/Electronic Industrial Maintenance Programs. Period of performance: April 1, 1998 through June 30, 1999.

that the Board of Trustees approves submission of these proposals to the appropriate funding agencies, and authorizes the execution of all documents by the Chancellor or the Executive Director of Resource Development, the Assistant Secretary of the Board and the General Counsel for the acceptance of any funding that may be forthcoming; said funds to be subject to the terms and conditions set forth by the grantors, and not to be expended by the Board for any other purposes.
