REPORTS

that Harry S Truman College staff has worked with Native American Education Services (NAES) to develop a transfer articulation agreement between the two institutions; and

that NAES agrees to offer admission and grant junior year status to graduates of Truman College who have completed the requirements for an AA or AAS degree with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale); NAES will only accept for credit those classes with a "C" grade or better; and

that NAES College, accredited by the NCA since 1984, has a mission to help meet the demands of Indian and tribal communities by developing within the Indian community, a system of higher education based upon the intellectual and philosophical traditions of the tribal world.
