JULY 1, 1998

The Board Committee on Academic and Student Services, called to order by Edward Czadowski, met Wednesday, July 1, 1998, to hear staff reports.

**ALSP 16 Week Module Restructuring Update:** A Report was presented on the 16 week ALSP Module Restructure. Upon a survey with the colleges, the following was determined that although the pilot was very well received, i.e. saving on registration, encouraging students to continue and/or continuing on to a credit program, there were still difficulties with inputting the registration into SPAS. This is presently being worked on at the Colleges.

**CCC/CPS GED Partnership Program:** A report was presented regarding the partnership program with City Colleges of Chicago and the Chicago Public Schools on the GED Program which will be offered at 12 High Schools throughout the city (2 in each region). CPS will fund this Program as well as recruit the students. The students taking this program must be a minimum of 18 years old. The program will have a minimum of 200 students at each sites.

**WYCC-TV Status Report:** A report on the activities of WYCC was included in the Board packet for the Board's review.
