**EXTEND AGREEMENTS FOR COLLEGE BOOKSTORE OPERATIONS  
DALEY, KENNEDY-KING, MALCOLM X, OLIVE-HARVEY, WRIGHT COLLEGES  
& WEST SIDE TECHNICAL INSTITUTE [DALEY COLLEGE]**

**REPORTS**

that the agreements to operate the bookstores at Daley, Kennedy-King, Malcolm X, Olive-Harvey, Wright Colleges and West Side Technical Institute of Daley College, will expire on August 1, 1998; and

that a Request for Proposals has been issued for a 3-year period; and that it is necessary to extend the current agreements for a 3-month period so that the new contract will begin after the start of the fall semester, that this is particularly important if there will be a change in the bookstore operators; and

that C&W Books, Inc., an MBE vendor, operates the bookstores at Daley, Kennedy-King, Malcolm X, Olive-Harvey and West Side Technical Institute; and Follett College Book Stores operates the bookstore at Wright College; and

that both firms have agreed to this extension with no change in the original contract terms.

**THE CHANCELLOR**

**RECOMMENDS**

that the Board of Trustees approves a 3-month extended agreement with C&W Books, Inc., Chicago, for the bookstore operations at Daley, Kennedy-King, Malcolm X, Olive-Harvey Colleges, and the West Side Technical Institute, from August 1, 1998 to November 1, 1998; and

that the Board of Trustees approves a 3-month extended agreement with Follett College Book Stores, Elmhurst, for the bookstore operations at Wright College, from August 1, 1998 to November 1, 1998; and

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chairman and Assistant Secretary to execute both extended agreements on behalf of the Board.
