GROLIER ONLINE LICENSE AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT made this Fifteenth (15th) day of March, 1999 by and between Grolier Publishing Co., Inc., Sherman Turnpike, Danbury, Connecticut 06816 ("Grolier") and City Colleges of Chicago ("Licensee") concerning online access to the Grolier encyclopedias ("Encyclopedia") specified below on Schedule A, hereto made a part hereof.

1. **GRANT:** In consideration of Licensee's agreement to the terms hereof, including payment of the license fee set forth in paragraph 3 hereof, Grolier hereby grants to Licensee the nonexclusive, nontransferable right to access and use the Encyclopedia during the Term solely in strict accordance with the terms hereof. All rights not expressly granted herein are reserved to Grolier.
2. **TERM:** The term of this Agreement shall be for one year or for a period as set forth in Schedule A hereto and made a part hereof and may be renewed only upon the written agreement of both parties.
3. **LICENSE FEE:** In consideration of the rights granted hereunder, Licensee shall pay to Grolier the license fee in the amount and on the payment terms as set forth in Schedule A.
4. **CONDITIONS OF USE:** Licensee shall be responsible for obtaining or providing all access lines and telephone and computer equipment, including browser software, modems, and/or other access devices necessary to access the Encyclopedia. Licensee shall not reproduce the Encyclopedia in whole or in part by recording onto computer tape, disc, microfiche, or in any other manner without Grolier's express prior written consent, provided, however, that to the extent the Encyclopedia provides the ability to save and print specifically selected information contained within the Encyclopedia, you and your Authorized Users may exploit these features, where such capacity is provided for within the Encyclopedia, for personal, noncommercial use only, preserving all copyright notices that are embedded by the Encyclopedia within those printed elements. The Encyclopedia contains copyrighted material, trade secrets, and other proprietary material and, in order to protect them, you may not decompile, reverse engineer, disassemble, or otherwise reduce the Encyclopedia to a human-perceivable form. Except as specifically provided for in this license, you may not copy, modify, rent, lease, or otherwise distribute the Encyclopedia, nor can you make the Encyclopedia available by "bulletin boards," nor may you create derivative works based upon the Encyclopedia in whole or in part. Remote

access shall be permitted, if at all, solely in accordance with the terms and limitations as set forth in Schedule A.

5. **THIRD-PARTY ACCESS:** The license granted hereunder for the Encyclopedia is limited to access from a single server as first herein above written and for noncommercial use only within the confines of said institution, or as otherwise explicitly provided by the terms set forth in Schedule A, provided that within said site(s), Licensee may permit multiple workstations to access the Encyclopedia solely by Authorized Users as set forth in Schedule A attached hereto, as secured by their individual ID numbers or other reasonable security measures to prevent unauthorized access to the Encyclopedia as established and maintained by Licensee and acceptable to Grolier. Licensee represents and warrants that the user population and site data provided in Schedule A are true and accurate representations of same. In the event Licensee utilizes a third-party proxy server for access, Licensee agrees that it will inform such proxy server of the terms and conditions hereof concerning access and will require that the proxy server comply therewith. At all times hereunder, Licensee shall remain liable for ensuring that all authorized use shall be in compliance with the terms of this Agreement. Licensee shall not disassemble the Encyclopedia, share, sublicense, lease, rent, sell, donate, assign, or transfer the Encyclopedia or the rights granted hereunder or make copies of the Encyclopedia except as expressly authorized hereunder.
6. **CONTENT AND COPYRIGHT:** Licensee acknowledges and agrees that the title to the Encyclopedia and all applicable copyrights, trade secrets, patents, and other intellectual property rights in and to the same are and shall remain vested in Grolier and its designees.
7. **LIMITATION OF LIABILITY/DISCLAIMER:**
 - a. EXCEPT AS SET FORTH IN THIS PARAGRAPH 7, THE ENCYCLOPEDIA IS LICENSED "AS IS" WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND. GROLIER EXPRESSLY DISCLAIMS ALL WARRANTIES, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO WARRANTIES AS TO ITS QUALITY, PERFORMANCE, MERCHANTABILITY, OR FITNESS FOR ANY PARTICULAR PURPOSE. GROLIER DOES NOT WARRANT THAT THE FUNCTIONS CONTAINED IN THE ENCYCLOPEDIA ARE ERROR FREE OR THAT DEFECTS IN THE ENCYCLOPEDIA WILL BE CORRECTED. THE LICENSEE SHALL BEAR THE ENTIRE RISK RELATING TO QUALITY, PERFORMANCE, AND SUITABILITY OF THE ENCYCLOPEDIA. GROLIER DOES NOT WARRANT OR MAKE ANY REPRESENTATIONS REGARDING THE USE OR THE RESULTS OF THE USE OF THE ENCYCLOPEDIA IN TERMS OF ITS CORRECTNESS, ACCURACY, RELIABILITY, OR OTHERWISE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ANY THIRD-PARTY CONTENT ACCESSED THROUGH HYPERTEXT LINKS IN THE ENCYCLOPEDIA. GROLIER EXPRESSLY DISCLAIMS ANY ENDORSEMENT OF, RESPONSIBILITY FOR, OR RELATIONSHIP OF

ANY KIND WITH ANY THIRD-PARTY SITES ACCESSIBLE THROUGH HYPERTEXT LINKS. NO ADVICE BY GROLIER OR A GROLIER-AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE SHALL CREATE A WARRANTY.

- b. Grolier represents and warrants that Licensee's use of the Encyclopedia in accordance with the terms of this Agreement shall not infringe any copyright or trademark rights of third parties. Grolier hereby indemnifies and holds Licensee harmless from and against any loss or liability arising out of Grolier's breach or breach alleged by a third party of Grolier's warranty hereunder, provided that Grolier is given timely notice of such claimed breach and is allowed to control the defense thereof.
- c. Except as set forth herein, Grolier shall in no event be liable for any direct, indirect, incidental, or consequential damages arising out of or in connection with the use, inability to use, or the performance of the Encyclopedia. In no event shall Grolier's liability exceed the license fees paid hereunder.
- d. The Encyclopedia contains hypertext links to third-party sites on the World Wide Web via the Grolier Internet Indextm. Grolier is not responsible for the content of any site so accessed by the Licensee. Grolier does not endorse any linked site or imply that the information on the linked site is error-free, correct, accurate, or reliable, nor that linked-site operators endorse Grolier.

8. TERMINATION:

- a. This Agreement is for the full term stipulated in paragraph 2. Except as specifically set forth herein, no refund or rebate of license fees paid by the Licensee shall be made for any portion of the term in which the Licensee elects not to use the Encyclopedia. Notwithstanding the forgoing, in the event the term of this license is for a period greater than one year, Licensee may terminate this agreement upon written notice provided to Grolier no later than 60 days prior to the close of any contract year hereof, in which event Grolier shall rebate any fees paid for any contract year following the one in which Licensee elects to terminate this Agreement.
- b. Grolier may terminate this Agreement for any or no reason upon 60 days written notice, in which case, all previously paid fees representing unused portions of the term of this license shall be repaid to the Licensee.

9. GOVERNMENT USE:

Licensee agrees that if Licensee is acquiring the Encyclopedia on behalf of any unit or agency of the United States Government, the following provisions apply. The Government, agrees: (i) if the Encyclopedia is supplied to the Department of Defense (DoD), the Encyclopedia is classified as "Commercial Computer Software" and the Government is acquiring only "restricted rights" to the Encyclopedia and its documentation as that term is defined in Clause 252227-
