The meeting of the Board Committee on Human Resources Services was held on Tuesday, 5 May 1998, at 10:00 am. Chairman James Dyson called the meeting to order. ## Staff Reports

Human Resources has begun the process of informational meetings conducted by SURS explaining new pension options; we expect July 1, 1998 implementation. We are also engaged in salary survey information-gathering for Information Technology professionals and have recommended a new salary structure to the officers of the district. Outside employment forms have been distributed, completed, and returned. Guardian Life Insurance has been proposing an increase in life insurance rates. Therefore, we may need to request bids for life insurance. The vision plan provider has agreed to hold the current fees for the coming year.

## New Business:

Board Chairman Gidwitz questioned the very late submission of overtime approvals and asked why overtime was not approved prior to the performance of overtime work rather than after. Michelle Pitre-Young responded that overtime is reported in the board report upon receipt from the campuses. Discussion among Presidents LeFevour, DeSombre, and Board members Gidwitz and Dyson regarding the processing of overtime for approval. Discussion concluded with agreement on the need for earlier submission of faculty overtime approvals.

At 10:10 a.m. Committee Chairman Dyson called for a closed session pursuant to Sections 2.c.1., 2.c.2, and 2.c.11 of the Open Meetings Act to discuss matters pertaining to personnel employment, collective bargaining, and litigation.
