REPORTS

that the purchasing office has received individual requests from Washington and Daley Colleges for the purchase of AutoCAD software for use in Computer Assisted Design architectural classes; and that if purchased separately by the two Colleges, this software cost would total \$37,600.00; and

that staff negotiated with the software developer, Autodesk Inc., San Raphael, California, for the purpose of acquiring a CCC site license for use by all Colleges; and that the requested software covers an entire suite of products consisting of a design and drafting module, mechanical design module, multimedia module, and geography module; and that CCC can purchase this site license for a one year period at \$50,000.00; and

that a review of purchases made during the past two years indicates that this software is used at five facilities: Truman, Olive-Harvey, Wright and Daley Colleges, and at the West Side Technical Institute; and all have ordered some version of this product from time to time; and

that Kennedy-King, Washington, Wright and Daley Colleges will use this software during FY1999; and that the purchase of a site license is economically advantageous when compared to individual license costs; and

that software licenses are exempt from competitive bidding under state law and Board Rules; and that Autodesk Inc. is the software developer and as such is the sole source for purchasing a site license.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees approves the Preferred Education Partnership Agreement with Autodesk, Inc., 111 McInnis Parkway, San Raphael, California, for a one-year site license as described above; and authorizes the Chairman and Assistant Secretary to execute the Partnership Agreement on behalf of the Board.
