RESOLUTION
INTEGRATION OF ILLINOIS BUSINESS & INDUSTRY STANDARDS [IBIS]
INTO CCC OCCUPATIONAL PROGRAM CURRICULUM
ALL COLLEGES

WHEREAS, there are national and state movements for developing and identifying Workforce Skill Standards; and that the Occupational Division of the Office of Academic Affairs, Planning and Research has begun the process toward assimilating CCC's occupational program curriculum with the Illinois Business & Industry Standards [IBIS] as they are published; and

WHEREAS, CCC has applied for and has received a grant from the Illinois Community College Board to support these efforts and firmly believes that this will result in 1988 being a landmark year for CCC due to this national/state revolutionary effort, and

WHEREAS, in Egyptian mythology, an IBIS is the earthly representation of THOTH, the deity of wisdom, language, communications, learning, healing, magic and science; and that THOTH represents wisdom as the highest function of the mind, serves as the gatekeeper between rational and intuitive realms, permits the articulate expression of intuitive thoughts, but also shows the way to knowledge beyond the limitations of thinking

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the IBIS shall be used as an appropriate symbol for the CCC during this curriculum standardization project, bringing together the critical junction of educational and training standards with those of the emerging Illinois occupational standards; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees herewith declares 1998 "The Year of the IBIS" as a symbol of CCC embarking upon the path of integrating the Illinois Business and Industry Standards into its occupational program curriculum
