U-PASS PROGRAM -- PILOT AGREEMENT

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that the Chicago Transit Authority [CTA] provides public transportation throughout the Chicago metropolitan area; and

that the CTA and 4 of the City Colleges: Kennedy-King, Olive-Harvey, Truman and Washington Colleges, share the desire to provide a transportation program that will reduce the demand for on-campus parking, reduce pollution, provide low-cost transportation for students, and increase access to the metropolitan area; and

that to address these needs, the CTA has established an experimental program entitled, U-Pass Program, for which CCC has been invited to participate; and that after discussions with local Student Government Associations and other student groups, the 4 Colleges have agreed to participate in a pilot of the U-Pass Program; and

that the U-Pass Program will provide full-time students who attend post-secondary institutions with unlimited rides on CTA buses and trains at a cost equal to \$60.00 per semester during the experimental period of one year beginning in fall 1998.

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chancellor to negotiate a contract with the CTA for the participation of Kennedy-King, Olive-Harvey, Truman and Washington Colleges in the U-Pass Program pilot for full-time students at a cost equal to \$60.00 per semester for each full-time student.
