SUMMARY OF THE BOARD COMMITTEE MEETING ON ACADEMIC AND STUDENT SERVICES

November 3, 1998

The Board Committee on Academic and Student Services, called to order by Edward Czadowski, met Tuesday, November 3, 1998, to hear staff reports.

District Articulation Initiatives Update A status report was presented related to current Districtwide Articulation Initiatives. The Districtwide committees have met six times during the Fall term that included CCC faculty and four year college representatives from the Chemistry, Biology, Physics and English disciplines. The purpose of the meetings are twofold: (1) respond to current Illinois Articulation Initiative issues; (2) provide a vehicle for faculty to faculty sessions with four year institutions to correlate CCC exit competencies with four year entrance competencies.

Also, an in-depth report was provided by Malcolm X College related to the Math and Allied Health Articulation meetings with University of Illinois, Chicago, which started during this summer. An articulation agreement signing ceremony will be held this Friday, November 6, 1998 at Malcolm X College for the Math component where Chancellor Watson and Chancellor Broski of UIC will officially sign the agreement. The Allied Health Articulation meetings for Dietetics, Med Lab and Pharmacy Tech with UIC are on-going.

WYCC-TV Status Report A report on the activities of WYCC was included in the Board packet for the Board's review. Clarification on the "Must Carry" FCCC implications for WYCC were discussed.
