that Joann Horton, Interim President of Kennedy-King College was invited to participate in the 1998 Symposium on Higher Education in Salzburg, Austria, from September 4-10, 1998, and

that the purpose of the Salzburg Seminar is for intellectual exchange among higher education leaders of the world for the purpose of effecting constructive institutional change. The leaders in the 1998 University Symposium, "Perspectives on Autonomy, Academic Systems, Goals and Social Responsibilities" discussed university administration and finance; academic structure and governance within the university; meeting the needs of students and the role of students in institutional affairs; and technology in higher education; and

that Dr. Horton was one of the forty higher educational leaders chosen from Central and Western Europe, Vietnam, and the United States because of their expertise, experience and commitment in higher education. She also co-chaired a workshop on "Academic Structure and Governance with the University." Participation in the Salzburg Seminar Programs is by invitation only.
