REPORTS

that the Board of Trustees has approved General Agreements with the Board of Commissioners of Cook County Hospital since 1980, to establish health education programs at Cook County Hospital, and said Agreement provides that specific programs will be covered by Addenda to said Agreement; and

that an Addendum for 1998-99 has been negotiated to use facilities at Cook County Hospital, 1835 West Harrison Street, Chicago, for clinical experience for a maximum of 6 students enrolled in Dietetic Technology, Dietetic Supervised Field Practice I, II and III, from October 17, 1998 to May 31, 1999.

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees approves the Addendum for 1998-99 to the General Agreement with the Board of Commissioners of Cook County Hospital, stating the terms and conditions whereby the Hospital will provide clinical facilities for students enrolled in the Dietetic Technology Program at Malcolm X College of Chicago during academic years 1998-1999, and authorizes the Chairman and Assistant Secretary to execute said Addendum on behalf of the Board
