that the purpose of this program is to provide a mechanism for students ages 10 to 13 to explore career opportunities in the communications and print media new technologies and methodologies of computer graphics software; and

that "Tech-Know Camp" allowed students to become a part of the global market in technology. The program included Macintosh Basics, Digital Imaging, Electronic Drawing and Illusion, and Web Page Design and Animatio; and.
