that during the Spring 1998 semester the Malcolm X College Student Services and Academic Support Departments piloted a program to provide personalized instruction through the Personalized Curriculum Institute to 16 students, who are young, single mothers from the Family Learning Center of Dr. Pedro Albizu Campos Alternative High School. The Family Learning Center is a day care center primarily serving Latino women; and

that the purpose of the program is to prepare these young mothers to enter college and prepare for a career. As a result of this collaborative effort, 40 students are participating in the program for the Fall 1998 semester.
