DECEASED

The Chancellor Reports:

Mr. Oscar Anderson, a tenured counselor at Daley College, passed away Sunday, August 23, 1998. Mr. Anderson was originally hired at Malcolm X College as the Dean of Instructional Services in 1982, and transferred to Daley College in 1987. His distinguished career in civic service commenced with 12 years of service in the Chicago Department of Human Services, and the Chicago Commission on Youth Welfare. His services in education included the Chicago Public Schools and YMCA Community College. Mr. Anderson's effectiveness in serving and representing the college and student communities will be missed.

Mr. Samuel Pearl Jordan passed away in June, 1998. Mr. Jordan was an adult education lecturer at Kennedy-King College since 1991, and was the founder of the college's Weight/Fitness Center. Mr. Jordan was a father figure to many on the campus, and a role model of positive support for those most needy in the student body. Many of his students received national acclaim. A former professional weight trainer and combat veteran of World War II, Mr. Jordan received many favorable press notices for his community and professional activities. Those who knew and trained with Mr. Jordan were granted a rare gift of his personality.

Mr. John Bonell, a College Electronics Technician, passed away August 1, 1998. Mr. Bonell was employed at Truman College in April 1980, after working as a student aide since 1977, and graduated from Truman's Data Processing Program. His work with students and staff in computer support, and as a laboratory assistant, was appreciated by both students and staff.

Ms. Patricia Jones passed away June 5, 1998. Employed as a faculty member at Kennedy-King College since 1974, Ms. Jones was a mainstay in the Business and Data Processing fields at the college. Her unique relationships with students and staff, and her supportive and positive presence in the college community will be missed.

Mr. Ronald McKinley, Assistant Professor in Radiology, Malcolm X College, passed away June 29, 1998. Mr. McKinley began his employment with the District in September 1973. He developed the Radiology Program to a position of prominence in allied health offerings, and served on the college's Governance Council, and the Institutional Enhancement Committee. He was also known throughout the college community for his musical gifts, and his generosity with his time. He sang at many college functions, such as graduations, inaugurations, and annual concerts.
