that proposals, contracts, and other special funding instruments are under development or have been submitted by staff at this time.

NEW GRANTS

Working Connections (PD# 9867). Malcolm X College has requested \$250,000 from the American Association of Community Colleges to develop training programs in information technology that respond to 21st century needs. Period of performance: January 1, 1999 through December 31, 2000.

CONTINUATION GRANTS

Probation Challenge Program (PD# 9868). Olive-Harvey College will receive \$675,000 (\$600,000 administrative costs and \$75,000 for student scholarships) from the Illinois Community College Board to distribute to Probation Challenge, Inc. to provide services associated with the Probation Challenge Program. Period of performance: September 1, 1998 through August 31, 1999.

CONTRACT AMENDMENTS

Foster Parent Training (PD# 9790). District Office has received a contract amendment from the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services for an additional \$39,547 to provide pre-service and in-service training to prospective and licensed foster parents. Period of performance: July 1, 1997 through June 30, 1998.

Child Care Training Project (PD# 9792). Harold Washington College has received a contract amendment from the Chicago Department of Human Services for an additional \$4,000 to provide academic course work and training to child care practitioners. Period of performance July 1, 1997 through June 30, 1998

CONTRIBUTIONS

The Gabriella and Paul Rosenbaum Foundation has approved a grant of \$38,000 to Richard J. Daley College. These funds will be used to support The Keystone Project: Building Study and Work Skills in the Mathematics classroom. This project will be directed by Professors M. Vali Siadat and Paul M. Musical, Math Department, Daley College.

that the Board of Trustees approves submission of these proposals to the appropriate funding agencies, and authorizes the execution of all documents by the Chancellor or the Executive Director of Resource Development, the Assistant Secretary of the Board and the General Counsel for the acceptance of any funding that may be forthcoming; said funds to be subject to the terms and conditions set forth by the grantors, and not to be expended by the Board for any other purposes.
