REPORTS that on July 21-23, 1998, Truman College conducted a pilot "Integrated Field Experience, "Education to Careers program which partnered Truman College faculty and high school teachers with business and industry for a three-day program and featured tours of Helene Curtis, Nalco Chemical Company, and Chicago Technical Park; and

that during these tours, participants discussed skills and competencies necessary for careers in these and similar companies, and

that these discussions were based on the Secretary's Commission on Achieving Necessary Skills (SCANS) and how educators may make their subjects relevant to real world needs; and

that 16 teachers from Amundson, Lakeview and Senn High Schools (CPS) and 9 instructors and professors from Truman College participated in the event.
