NEW GRANTS

Chicago Consortium of Higher Education (PD#9920)

City Colleges of Chicago with the Adler Planetarium and Astronomy Museum, Chicago Manufacturing Center, Chicago Public Schools, Chicago State University, Chicago Library System, Columbia College Chicago, DeVry Institute of Technology-Chicago, DuSable Museum of African-American History, Illinois Institute of Technology, Lincoln Park Zoo, Loyola University of Chicago, John Marshall Law School, North Park University, Northeastern Illinois University, Robert Morris College, Roosevelt University, Teachers Academy of Mathematics and Science, The Field Museum, and the University of Illinois at Chicago has received a \$735,000 Telecommunications-Based Instructional Delivery System HECA Capital Grant from the Illinois State Board of Higher Education.

CONTINUATION GRANTS

Truants' Alternative and Optional Education Program (PD#9915)

District Office has requested \$2,273,000 from the Illinois State Board of Education to fund the Alternative Education Consortium. This consortium is a unique partnership between public, private and community-based organizations designed to provide alternative educational programs and services to reclaim youth 16-21 years old that have dropped out of high school. Period of Performance: July 1, 1999 through June 30, 2000.

National Youth Sports Program (PD#9916)

District Office has requested \$335,000 from the National Collegiate Athletic Association to support the operation of the National Youth Sports Program at Daley, Kennedy-King, Malcolm X, Olive-Harvey, and Truman Colleges. Period of Performance: June 1, 1999 through May 31, 2000.
