the Board of Trustees has annually renewed Agreements with Coast Telecourses for use of telecourses for open air broadcast since 1984; and

that Agreements have been re-negotiated with Coast Telecourses to license rights to 3 telecourses from June 1, 1999 through May 31, 2002 (unless otherwise noted) at the fees listed plus an enrollment fee of \$20.00 per student.

- Universe: The Infinite Frontier as Astronomy 201 for a flat fee of \$3,000.00;
- Marketing Revised as Business 231 for a flat fee of \$750.00;
(Effective from January 1, 1999 through December 31, 1999)
- Cycles of Life: Exploring Biology as Biology 101 for a flat fee of \$2,700.00;
(Effective from September 1, 1999 through August 31, 2002)

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees approves the Agreements with Coast Telecourses stating the terms and conditions whereby the City Colleges of Chicago is granted 3 telecourse licenses totaling \$6,450.00 plus an enrollment fee of \$20.00 per registered student; and authorizes the Chairman and Assistant Secretary to execute the Agreements on behalf of the Board.

- 5. PAYMENT: In consideration of the rights granted by CCCD, Licensee shall pay to CCCD the following: LICENSE FEE: \$3,000.00; STUDENT ROYALTY: \$20.00 per enrolled student each and every time Telecourse is offered by Licensee.
- 6. PAYMENT SCHEDULE: To be invoiced September '99 and September '00 for \$1500.00 each time for license fees; July for Summer, October for Fall, and March for Spring for each year covered by agreement for student royalty fee.
