THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that it is the policy of the City Colleges of Chicago to administer a nationally normed comprehensive exam to each Associate Degree Program nursing student which must be successfully completed before graduation, and that tests will be administered before the end of March this year to allow for any additional instruction or remediation needed by students; and

that the Nursing Department Chairs have voted to use a nationally normed computerized test from Health Education Systems Inc. (HESI) for the 1998 fall semester, the 1999 spring and summer semesters; and

that the estimated total cost of the HESI tests is based on 360 students at a cost of \$28 per student; however, actual expenditures may vary based on the number of tests required.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees ratifies the Chairman's pre-approval to issue a purchase order in the total estimated amount of \$10,080.00 to Health Education Systems Inc., 1107 Hidden Coves, Point Blank, Texas, for the nursing comprehensive tests for FY1999 which are required prior to the March 26, 1999 testing date.
