that Kelly Sharkey of the Counseling Department, earned a \$1000 grant from the Illinois Community College Faculty Association to be used for a teaching and learning workshop to be offered to community college counselors in the State of Illinois in Spring 2000 with about 100 participants expected; and that the workshop will be co-sponsored by the National and Illinois Career Development Associations.

FLOR WINTER

that a Spanish GED teacher in the ALSP Program, Flor Winter, has received a Kohl/McCormick Early Childhood Teaching Award for her work at the Lakeview Early Intervention Program of the Chicago Association for Retarded Citizens. This Award recognizes outstanding teachers who work with children up to age 8, and is co-sponsored by the McCormick Tribune Foundation and the Dolores Kohl Education Foundation. Ms. Winter's daytime commitment to the Intervention Program greatly enriches her evening teaching of the Spanish GED to Truman students. In addition to an honorarium, the award offers a year of free interactive classroom programming by the Kohl Children's Museum. Ms. Winter came to the United States from Columbia eleven years ago.

MARY BETH GUINAN

that Mary Beth Guinan, Director of the ALSP Computer Lab, was featured in newspots produced by NBC-5, WGN-9 and CLTV; and that the newspots focused on Ms. Guinan's Icon Language System [informally titled "Instant English"] which she developed with a grant from CCC; and the system is designed to speed the learning of English as a Second Language and cuts the time in half that students need to learn proper pronoun usage and other skills specific to the English language.
