CPS STUDENTS

that the Rassias Language Institute of Washington College conducted the Third Annual Rassias Language Immersion Camp for high school students in French, Spanish and German between July 6 and July 16, 1999, sponsored by the CPS Office of Language and Cultural Education; and

that under the supervision of Rassias-trained teachers, the students reviewed grammar and conversational materials of the previous scholastic year, plus preparatory materials for the upcoming semester, together with cultural lectures, films and outings; and

that the program culminated in a Commencement Program and Reception attended by students, families, faculty and friends, which included a video transmission of Professor John Rassias, student performances in the target languages, and certificates conferred by Vice President John Wozniak.

CPS TEACHERS

that the Rassias Language Institute has been designated by the CPS Office of Language and Cultural Education to train all language and career faculty of the recently created Career Academies in the Rassias Methodology; and

that this ongoing training will enable the teachers to assist the students more effectively as they pursue their language to career studies; and

that twenty-three language and career faculty from the academies attended their first Rassias Method Workshop on June 25, 28 and 29, 1999 and will attend future workshops to improve the skills acquired at the initial workshop.
