REPORTS that as of end of spring 1999, headcount enrollment in continuing education and special interest in all subterms reached 27,942 students. End-of-Term enrollment is presented for continuing education and special interest courses because they start at different times during the term and are not captured in the traditional census date statistics.

Headcount enrollment in continuing education, subterms A and B, reached 6,384 students at the end of spring 1999. FTE enrollment reached 1,300 students.

A total of 21,558 students were enrolled in special interest courses, subterms C and D, by the end of spring 1999. FTE enrollments for special interest courses are not reported because they do not have a credit hour value.
