NEW GRANTS

Information Technology Job Shadow Scholarship Program (PD# 99104) Harold Washington College has prepared a proposal requesting \$29,610 from the Illinois Community College Board to inform high school juniors and seniors of information technology careers and scholarship opportunities at the College as part of Harold Washington College's recruiting efforts. Scholarship recipients will be required to participate in job shadowing with employees of one of Harold Washington College's information technology business partners. Period of Performance: January 1, 2000 through January 31, 2001.

Mobile Virtual Reality Van for Recruitment (PD# 99105) Malcolm X College has prepared a proposal requesting \$25,000 from the Illinois Community College Board to rent and refurbish a fifteen passenger van to use as a mobile virtual reality teaching and recruitment laboratory. The van will house and transport virtual reality equipment, lessons, and instructional and recruitment materials to local high school and middle schools. Period of Performance: January 1, 2000 through January 31, 2001.

Virtual Reality for Recruitment Information Technology (PD# 99106) Malcolm X College has prepared a proposal requesting \$50,000 from the Illinois Community College Board to develop virtual reality computer program lessons which will be used with local secondary schools for recruitment of students into information technology programs at Malcolm X College. Period of Performance: January 1, 2000 through January 31, 2001.

College Excel: Enhancing Graphic Communications (PD# 99107) Kennedy-King College has prepared a proposal requesting \$25,000 from the Illinois Community College Board to enhance the technological infrastructure of the Graphic Communications Program at Kennedy-King College by integrating a multimedia component into the curricula. The project will facilitate the integration of animation, sound, and interface design into the College's graphic communications course offerings. Period of Performance: January 1, 2000 through June 30, 2000.

CONTINUATION GRANTS

Foster Parent Training Program (PD# 99108) Harold Washington College has been awarded \$800,211 from the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services to continue to provide foster parent training and related services. Period of Performance: July 1, 1999 through June 30, 2000.


