REPORTS

that in Board Report 21095 dated February 4, 1999 the Board approved the following legislative representatives to provide lobbyist services for CCC: Mayer Brown & Platt, 190 S. LaSalle Street, Chicago, Lezlie Baskerville, Washington, D.C., and Charles Pizer, Arlington, VA; and

that the firm of Mayer, Brown and Platt has provided legislative representation of the District in Springfield during prior fiscal years and their past services have been beneficial to CCC's interests; and that the firm's partners and associates in Washington, DC will be available on an as-needed basis; and

that Lezlie Baskerville has twenty years of experience as a lobbyist at the federal level and will represent CCC in developing legislative strategies and monitoring legislation pertaining to higher education; and

that Charles Pizer possesses extensive expertise and knowledge in dealing with federal entities, and also represents the City of Chicago and the Chicago Public Schools in Washington, DC; and

that the proposals submitted by these legislative representatives are recommended for approval for the period between November 1, 1999 through December 31, 2000.

RECOMMENDS


that the Board of Trustees approves the issuance of a purchase orders as follows:

- ▶ to Mayer, Brown & Platt, 190 S. LaSalle Street, Chicago, at a monthly fee of \$8,333.33 plus out-of-pocket expenses not to exceed \$1,000.00 per month effective November 1, 1999 to October 31, 2000; and
- ▶ to Lezlie Baskerville, 1818 N Street NW, Washington, DC, at a monthly fee of \$2,500.00 plus out-of-pocket expenses not to exceed \$1,000.00 per month effective January 1, 2000 to December 31, 2000; and
- ▶ to Charles Pizer, 1600 Wilson Boulevard, Arlington, VA, at a monthly fee of \$6,000.00 plus out-of-pocket expenses not to exceed \$1,500.00 per month effective January 1, 2000 to December 31, 2000.
