that the NuLambda Chapter of the Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society at Truman College will host the national organization's regional conference, November 19 through 21; and


that the theme for the conference, which will be attended by more than 400 PTK members from 115 chapters across the country, is "The Past As Prologue;" and
