EMERGENCY SNOW REMOVAL  
MALCOLM X AND KENNEDY-KING COLLEGES

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that the recent snowfall has resulted in an extraordinary amount of drifted and accumulated snow banks; and

that it was necessary to remove and relocate piled snow from the campuses of Malcolm X and Kennedy-King Colleges to assure access to parking spaces, including handicapped parking slots, for clear walkway access and security, and to improve visibility; and

that staff solicited informal quotations to remove the accumulated snow to alternate areas at:

that these are estimated totals based upon multiplying the estimated number of hours required for each piece of snow removal equipment by the unit price quoted, and that actual expenditures may vary based upon actual time and equipment required, and the prices are considered reasonable and acceptable; and

that emergency action is required to avoid disruption to student services and college operations; and

that an analysis of district-wide snow removal expenditures and estimated requirements will be provided at the next meeting of the Board Committee on Finance and Administrative Services.

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees ratifies the Chairman's pre-approval to authorize the issuance of purchase orders and payment of invoices to the vendors listed above for emergency snow removal at Malcolm X and Kennedy-King Colleges.
