# SEVENTH FLOOR RENOVATION - ADDITIONAL COSTS DISTRICT OFFICE

#### THE CHANCELLOR

#### **REPORTS**

that in Board Report #20498 dated 3-5-1998, the Board awarded the 7th floor renovation project at 226 West Jackson to the low bidder, R. Rudnick Construction in an amount not to exceed \$535,750.00; and that in Board Reports #20691 dated 6-4-1998, #20858 dated 9-3-1998, and #20978 dated 11-5-1998, the Board approved change orders in the amount of \$4,631.00, \$22,129.30, and \$15,187.00 respectively, bringing the total project to \$577,697.30; and

that due to conditions outside the vendor's control which were discovered during the renovation work, there have been additional costs incurred for materials and labor to repair and replace VAV boxes, controllers and other HVAC equipment, and install conduit system for future fiber optic cabling needed for the 7<sup>th</sup> floor operations, in the total additional amount of \$6,853.85 (1.3%), for a cumulative total of \$48,801.15, or 9.1% over the original contract amount; and

that staff members in the Office of Information Technology and Facilities Planning have reviewed the increased costs and find them reasonable and acceptable; and

that R. Rudnick & Company is in compliance with District M/WBE requirements.

### **RECOMMENDS**

that the Board of Trustees approves the issuance of a purchase order addendum in the amount of \$6,853.85, bringing the total purchase order to \$584,551.63, to R. Rudnick & Company, 1040 S. Milwaukee Avenue, Wheeling, Illinois, for the additional costs as described above.
