that earlier this year the U.S. Department of Energy invited applications for student internships at the Argonne National Laboratory for the summer of 1999; and

that faculty in the Departments of Natural Sciences and Computer Information Systems identified and nominated highly qualified students for these internships; and

that Dr. Harold Myron, Director of Educational Programs at Argonne, has indicated that Daley College has the largest number of student interns from any of the 75 colleges invited to apply, more than one-third of all the interns in the midwestern states, and the highest percentage of applicants receiving internships: 100%; and

that the 9 Daley College students who received these internships will receive a weekly stipend and housing allowance; and according to Dr. Myron, "will be working at the forefront of research, side-by-side and shoulder-to-shoulder with top rated, internationally known research scientists" in the fields of biotechnology, human genetics, and structure biology; and

that Daley College has the only faculty member from the midwestern states awarded a faculty internship for the summer: Professor Barbara McCormick.
