REPORTS

that Daley College currently operates an Upward Bound Program funded by the Department of Education, providing after-school instruction, tutoring, and support services to high school sophomores, juniors, and seniors of Curie, Farragut, and Kelly High Schools; and

that this program has received notification that it has been funded to continue services for the next four years, totaling \$960,000; and

that objectives of this program include improvement of students' academic performance in high school, improvement of high school graduation rates, preparation for college study, and enrollment/retention in post-secondary education; and

that this program has just graduated its first class of 25 seniors, with graduates attending universities such as DePaul, Illinois State, Northern Illinois, St. Xavier, and the University of Illinois; and

that graduates are receiving substantial scholarships, with four-year scholarships including Golden Apple awards and a four year scholarship to the University of Illinois at Urbana College of Engineering; and

that this renewal grant will enable the College to continue providing such opportunities to students in the Upward Bound Program.
