- Chairman Dyson, members of the Board, Chancellor Watson, Officers of the District, faculty, students, staff, and all others present, good morning.
- During the month of June, Council Secretary Barbara Washington, a number of other faculty throughout the system and I worked closely with Vice Chancellor Deidra Lewis, Associate Vice Chancellor Ferreri, and President Zerrie Campbell to coordinate the selection of a pool of City College faculty to serve on the ISBE curriculum panels that review the subject content in each of the major academic disciplines and vocational specialties offered by the public schools. Our faculty were asked by the ICCB and our own administration to join these panels to further expand Chancellor Watson's K-16 initiative. Faculty were found to participate on all fourteen panels with all colleges in our system contributing to the effort. From Kennedy-King College, English Professor Randall Davenport and Social Science Professor Robert Cruthird have agreed to serve on the panels.
