THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that there is an instructional need for a physiological monitoring system to be used in conjunction with the human patient simulator which was approved in Board Report #21260 on 5-6-1999; and

that this computerized monitoring system displays physiological measurements of blood pressure, heart rate, temperature, ECG, respiration, oxygen saturation output from the simulator; and

that the College staff recommends the system manufactured by Hewlett Packard, Andover, Massachusetts, at a total cost of \$21,838.44; and that this price includes a 12% educational discount which is competitive with major hospital group pricing; and

that the monitoring system is compatible with the previously-purchased patient simulator and is commonly used in hospitals where MX students will practice; and

that this purchase is exempt from competitive bidding requirements.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees approves the issuance of a purchase order in the total amount of \$21,838.44 to Hewlett Packard, 3000 Minuteman Road, Andover, Massachusetts, for the physiological monitoring system for the Nursing and Allied Health Programs at Malcolm X College.
