that during the 1998-1999 academic year the Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities (HACU) selected two Wright College students to participate in the National Internship Program. Laura Noriega was selected to intern during Spring 1999 for the Library of Congress in Washington, D.C.; and Eduardo Ruiz has been selected to intern during Summer 1999 for the USA Environmental Protection Agency in Chicago. The internship program is designed to allow college students to experience the diversity of careers that exists in the federal and corporate sectors; and

that the outreach is a team effort of Maria de L. Llopiz, Counseling Department, and Daisy Mitchell, Director of Job Placement. The proactive approach is an initiative to link career counseling and job placement services for students to obtain the maximum benefits. The students will be recognized during the College's Spring 1999 Student Awards Banquet; and

that over 1600 students applied nationwide for these internship opportunities. This outreach effort will continue to ensure that Wright College students have the best possible Community College educational experience.
