WHEREAS, Section 1.7 of the Rules for the Management and Government of the City Colleges of Chicago, provides for amendments to said Rules; and

WHEREAS, the administration has proposed amendments to Article IV, Section 4.3 as outlined below; and

WHEREAS, the Board Committee on Finance and Administrative Services has reviewed these amendments and concurs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said amendments to Article IV and Appendix 17 of the Rules for the Management and Government of the City Colleges of Chicago shall be effective immediately upon passage of this Resolution.

B. FEES

1. Center for Open Learning Material Fees: \$20.00 per course taken via television or cassette, payable in addition to tuition and any other applicable fees.
2. Miscellaneous Course Fees: Specific fees related to the costs of individual college-level, continuing education, special interest, and clock hour courses may be assessed in addition to any other listed tuition and fees.
3. Lab Fees: \$20.00 per course for College Credit Lab Courses (excluding Physical Education).
4. Activity Fee at Kennedy-King, *Malcolm X*, Olive-Harvey, Truman and Washington Colleges: Up to \$60.00 per semester, or prorated for terms that are longer or shorter than a semester at a rate that is not to exceed \$.50 per day, ~~effective for the Fall 1998 Semester.~~
5. **Parking Fee: All Colleges have the option of charging a \$5 per semester parking fee. Full-time students who pay the Activity Fee [#4 above] will receive a complimentary parking pass if the College has opted to charge for student parking.**
6. **Technology Fee: \$3 per credit hour, up to a maximum of 9 credit hours [not to exceed a total of \$27 per semester].**
