**CLINICAL FACILITIES AGREEMENT
DIAGNOSTIC MEDICAL IMAGING PROGRAMS
WRIGHT COLLEGE**

REPORTS

that there is a need for facilities in which students enrolled in the Diagnostic Medical Imaging Programs at Wright College can receive clinical experience; and that an Agreement has been negotiated to use facilities at:

- > Shriners Hospitals for Crippled Children, 2211 N. Oak Park, Chicago
(Effective February 1, 1999 through January 31, 2000 with automatic renewal)

that malpractice insurance requirements are within the coverage carried by the City Colleges of Chicago

RECOMMEND

that the Board of Trustees approves the Agreement with the Shriners Hospital for Crippled Children stating the terms and conditions whereby the facility will be available to conduct the Diagnostic Medical Imaging Programs at Wright College; and authorizes the Chairman and Assistant Secretary to execute said Agreement on behalf of the Board.

AFFILIATION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 1st day of February, 2000, by and between **SHRINERS HOSPITALS FOR CHILDREN**, a Colorado not-for-profit corporation, which owns and operates the Chicago Hospital (hereinafter referred to as "HOSPITAL"), and the Board of Trustees of Community College District 508. County of Cook and State of Illinois at **WILBUR WRIGHT COLLEGE**, located at 4300 North Narragansett Avenue, Chicago Illinois 60634-4229 (hereinafter referred to as "SCHOOL").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, it is agreed by the parties to be of mutual interest and advantage that the students and faculty of the SCHOOL be given the opportunity to utilize the HOSPITAL for clinical and educational purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing and in further consideration of the mutual benefits, the parties to this Agreement agree as follows:

1. The HOSPITAL will permit students of the SCHOOL to practice as Diagnostic Medical Imaging Students under the supervision and responsibility of a clinical faculty of the SCHOOL. The student will participate in providing, but shall not be solely responsible for, patient care services rendered at HOSPITAL as part of the student's experiences. The HOSPITAL shall retain ultimate responsibility for patient care. The individual faculty members will be responsible to the liaison person designated by the HOSPITAL to oversee the training of these students.
2. The period of assignment, number of students during each period and distribution of students between areas of the HOSPITAL will be mutually agreed upon between the SCHOOL and the HOSPITAL at the beginning of each clinical training period.
3. The SCHOOL will not discriminate against any applicant for enrollment in its course of study because of race, creed, sex, religion, disability or national origin. The SCHOOL and its faculty accept full responsibility for the students' learning activities.
4. The SCHOOL shall assume responsibility for seeing that all their students and faculty members comply with the policies, procedures and Rules and Regulations of HOSPITAL, and for seeing that all their students and faculty members respect the confidential nature of all information which may come to them with respect to patient and hospital records.
5. The HOSPITAL may request the SCHOOL to withdraw from the HOSPITAL any student whose performance is unsatisfactory or whose characteristics and activities are detrimental to the HOSPITAL in carrying out its healthcare responsibilities.

6. It is understood between the parties that under no circumstances is any member of the SCHOOL student body or faculty to be considered an agent or employee of the HOSPITAL.

7. a. The HOSPITAL agrees to save and hold the SCHOOL harmless against any legal claims, demands of judgment against the SCHOOL arising out of any activities performed by the HOSPITAL'S agents and employees pursuant to this Agreement and agrees to reimburse the SCHOOL for all reasonable expenses, including attorney's fees, incurred by the SCHOOL in defending any such claim or claims.
- b. The SCHOOL agrees to save and hold the HOSPITAL harmless against any legal claims, demands or judgment against the HOSPITAL arising out of any activities performed by the SCHOOL'S students or instructors pursuant to this Agreement and agrees to reimburse the HOSPITAL for all reasonable expenses, including attorney's fees, incurred by the HOSPITAL in defending any such claim or claims.

8. The SCHOOL will arrange for liability and malpractice insurance coverage for its faculty members and students assigned to the HOSPITAL and agrees to verify that each student so participating has acquired such insurance coverage.

9. The HOSPITAL further agrees as follows:

- (A) to provide to the SCHOOL the necessary space or facilities for conference and classroom areas for student teaching as available;
- (B) to provide lounge and locker space for students, as available;
- (C) to allow students and faculty members of the SCHOOL to utilize the HOSPITAL'S eating facilities at the students' and faculty's sole expense;
- (D) to provide first aid treatment for students or faculty members who are injured or become ill while at the HOSPITAL;
- (E) to provide an orientation for the SCHOOL'S faculty members and plan with them all joint programs;
- (F) to conduct an orientation for each student in respect to the policies and Rules and Regulations of the HOSPITAL and the facilities of the HOSPITAL.

10. It is understood between the parties that there will be no exchange of funds between the SCHOOL and HOSPITAL.

11. This Agreement is for a term of one (1) year, and thereafter from year to year, unless terminated by either party upon giving three (3) months' advance notice to the other party by certified mail, return receipt requested.
