Microsoft Training

that West Side Technical Institute is scheduled to provide the first class of Microsoft classes beginning this month for 20 employees of Favorite Brands Foods; and that staff will continue to develop computer and other classes for subsequent groups of 20 employees each from Favorite Brands.

CSX Railroad Conductor Training

that in cooperation with the Mayor's Office of Workforce Development, administrative, clerical, and logistical support for Conductor Training for identified prospective CSX Railroad employees is being provided; and that the final session will be completed on May 6, 1999; and that upon successful completion of the CSX training program, a total of 75 participants will receive further training in Atlanta, Georgia resulting in employment possibilities with CSX.

Metra Railroad Employee Training

that a partnership with Metra has begun which will provide training for Metra employees; and that 130 will be enrolled for each of three 13-week courses in Railroad Signalman Training, the first began April 5, 1999 at West Side Technical Institute; and that staff will be working with Metra to develop a full range of industrial programs for Metra employees.

Course Work for Job Corps

that The New Chicago Job Corps Center will train 320 recruits; and that West Side Technical Institute is developing vocational training courses in precision metal working and industrial maintenance occupations; and that the first courses developed will be taught at West Side Technical Institute beginning in the 1999 summer term.
