THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that there is a need for the colleges to utilize bus services throughout the year for various programs, sports teams, etc., such as: the National Youth Sports Program (NYSP) at Malcolm X, Daley and Truman Colleges each summer, the Taxicab Training Program sponsored by Washington College, the Upward Bound program at Daley, as well as transportation for sports teams at various colleges throughout the year; estimated District-wide expenses for bus service for FY 99 were approximately \$186,000.00; and

that Chicago Public Schools (CPS) has awarded three-year contracts (7-23-99 through 6-30-02) to twenty-eight (28) firms for bus services at their July, 1999 meeting (see attached); Board approval is recommended to utilize the CPS contract vendors throughout the year to provide bus service for the colleges; the intent is for the colleges get competitive quotations from these vendors as needed for their bus transportation requirements; each contract bus vendor meets all City of Chicago M/WBE requirements and almost all of them are Chicago-based; in addition, this will reduce the time spent bidding smaller bus requirements and increase the opportunity for Chicago M/WBE firms to provide service to the District; and

the following firms have been awarded contracts by CPS for the period of July 23, 1999 through June 30, 2002;


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THE CHANCELLOR

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

