
that Daley College has been active in developing Articulation Agreements with Colleges and Universities throughout the state, including Agreements with Governors State University for transfer of AA degrees in accounting, business technology, computer information systems, criminal justice, and nursing; and

that to extend transfer opportunities for students, staff at Daley College have been working with staff at Columbia College to develop an Articulation Agreement in the field of management; and

that an Agreement has been completed under which A.A. graduates in Business at Daley College can transfer to Columbia College with junior status, having completed 84 hours in a prescribed program at Daley College; and

that this Agreement can now serve as a model for articulation by other Colleges in the district, expediting the successful transfer of students to the Columbia College bachelor's degree in Management, and thereby expanding students' options in continuing their education.
