that 20 nursing students from Puerto Rico visited the United States under the sponsorship of the Equity Alliance for Global Nursing, a partnership between Truman and Daley Colleges and Puerto Rican educational institutions; and


that the 20 student nurses worked as interns in Chicago hospitals during the day and took English as a Second Language classes at Truman at night, focusing on medical terminology and English phrases most critical to nurses working in Chicago hospitals; and

that the Equity Alliance is a program of the non-profit educational consulting firm, Equity Research Corp., led by Miriam Cruz; and

that the Alliance will also arrange for associate degree nurses graduating from Truman and Daley Colleges to complete their bachelor degrees in Puerto Rico; and

that in return for the nurses coming back to Chicago hospitals to work, the hospitals have agreed to pay educational costs.
