INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH

REPORTS

that City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) has entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Chicago Board of Education (CBOE) for the entitled Education to Careers Project. The purpose of this project is to provide Women in Trades Opportunity Program to qualified participating Chicago Public School Students as part of an Education to Careers Grant issued to CBOE by the Illinois State Board of Education; and


that CCC will conduct Women in Trades Opportunity Program to provide orientation and information sessions for 250 women and prepare at least 50 to pass entrance exams for union apprentices and/or other trades-related programs. Participants will attend 200 hours of class; and

that CBOE will pay CCC \$400,000 during the term of the Agreement, April 6, 2000 through August 30, 2000, with an option to renew this Agreement for three (3) additional one year periods upon mutual consent.

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees approves the Intergovernmental Agreement with the Chicago Board of Education for the Education to Careers Program and authorizes the Vice Chairman and Assistant Board Secretary to negotiate and execute an Agreement, subject to legal review, for the project.
