
that the nursing program at Daley College has a long and highly distinguished reputation, producing highly skilled registered nurses for hospitals and other health support organizations throughout the city and suburbs, and that Daley College Nursing Program has been highly rated by accrediting agencies and by health professionals in the field for many years; and

that results have now been received from the 1999 NCLEX-RN examination, which was administered to 76,523 nursing program following graduation from nursing education programs, including 3,999 students in Illinois; and that the average pass rate in Illinois was 83%, compared with the national average pass rate of 85%; and

that the pass rate of students from the Daley Nursing Program was 97%, representing the successful performance of 29 of 30 students taking the test for the first time; and

that the student was given additional assistance, took the exam again, and passed, raising the success rate to 100%. For the past four years, Daley College has had a 100% combined pass rate for students taking the examination the first and second time.
