REPORTS

that in order to enhance student access to CCC classes and programs it is necessary to make provide software and hardware which will provide voice and web registration for students, as well as the ability to process student credit card payments on line; and

that OIT staff have reviewed system options and recommend acceptance of the solutions from TouchNet Information Systems, Inc., Lenexa, KS; TouchNet has proposed to provide its LogiXstream Web and Voice Solutions to CCC which include the following features:

- Ability to interface with CCC's existing legacy system – SPAS – for student records;
- Utilization of n-tier architecture, non-proprietary tools and languages such as Java, XML and JSP's, as well as non-proprietary hardware components for the Voice solution;
- PeopleSoft interface – TouchNet is a PeopleSoft Strategic Alliance Partner and has web and voice student record applications for the PeopleSoft student system; in addition, TouchNet is committed to ongoing releases of PeopleSoft;
- E-Commerce – TouchNet provides a turnkey application to allow e-commerce payment of student account balance and other functions utilizing their credit card.

that the total cost of the TouchNet system proposal is as follows:

- Web Component - \$305,010.00
- Payment Gateway - \$ 74,755.50
- Voice Component - \$130,130.00
- Total \$509,895.50

that OIT has reviewed TouchNet's proposal and has determined that the costs are reasonable and acceptable; and

that this purchase is exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements.

THE CHANCELLOR


RECOMMENDS
