
that Mr. Henry English, President and C.E.O. of the Black United Fund of Illinois, and 1970 graduate of Crane Jr. College (now Malcolm X College) was honored in Decatur, Illinois by the Illinois Community College Trustee Association as the Illinois Distinguished Community College Alumnus for the year 2000; and

that Mr. English was the president of the student government at Malcolm X College and served as president of the City Colleges of Chicago Student Government Association in 1970.

That Mr. English earned his baccalaureate degree from the University of New Hampshire and a Masters Degree for Cornell University. Mr. English founded the Black United Fund of Illinois in 1985, and that philanthropic group has funded more than 450 grassroots organizations since its inception.


In his acceptance speech, Mr. English expressed his thanks to Malcolm X College for the support and guidance he received during his enrollment.
