OPENING ENROLLMENT REPORT: Summer 2000

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS that as of Census Date, unduplicated headcount enrollment in all programs reached 52,294 students, and the Full-Time-Equivalent (FTE) enrollment reached 25,479 FTE students (Tables 1 and 2). Opening summer enrollment figures represent a *snapshot of enrollments* as of Census Date (June 26, 2000) and do not include registrations that will take place in several programs during the summer term. State and federal government agencies use census date information to report educational statistics.


A total of 42,280 headcount students and 24,465 FTE students were reported to the Illinois Community College Board. ICCB figures do not include Special Interest or Military enrollments because they are not reimbursed by the state.

Headcount enrollment in the credit program reached 11,700 students, a decrease of 5 percent over the previous year. The credit FTE enrollment reached 7,254 FTE students, which represents a 6 percent decrease over the previous year.

Headcount enrollment in college credit, pre-credit, and vocational skills reached 12,947 students, a decrease of 3.9 percent compared to summer 1999 (Table 1 and Figure 1). These programs represent the traditional baccalaureate/transfer, occupational and remedial courses in the district. FTE enrollment reached 7,961 students, a decrease of 4.9 percent (Table 2 and Figure 1).


Headcount enrollment in the ALSP program reached 27,436 students, a decrease of 4.7 percent compared to summer 1999 (Tables 1 and 3; Figure 3). FTE enrollment reached 15,547 FTE students, a decrease of 8.8 percent (Tables 2 and 3; Figure 3).
